COVID VACCINATION GUIDE AND UPDATES

Sites will not be able to receive vaccine or commence vaccination until confirmation has been received by NHS England that you have both accepted the terms of the National Enhanced Service and your site is ready to vaccinate.

Important points to note.

- You should make appropriate arrangements to administer vaccinations in accordance with the appropriate service specification for your site.
- Your site must continue to meet the relevant contractual requirements throughout the programme.
- The co-administration form for Covid-19 and flu vaccinations has been delayed. It is now expected to go live in early October.
- Stocktakes are used to inform the Targeted Deployment Model (TDM).
- Sites must complete a stock take on receipt of vaccine delivery and refresh this at least every 7 days.
- Stocktake rule sites that trigger a replenishment will be denied if the stocktake rule is breached.
- Record a stocktake (at least once every 7 days) across each vaccine type even if the stock held is zero.
- The current vaccine for adult is Comirnaty BA4/5.
- Comirnaty 30 XBB can be used from the 2nd of October and the BA4/5 can be quarantined at sites.
- Vaccination events must be recorded at the time they are done.
- If sites don't have access to PharmOutcome system, they must not vaccinate.
- Caution with data entry some systems still have older vaccines in the list (some entries of Comirnaty BAI/Original).
- Data latency leads to duplicated vaccines, increased side effects and potentially non-payment.
- Data latency and wrong vaccine errors are reported on and will be followed up.
