

Lateral Flow Device Service

Now Live and FREE* to view

Lateral flow device tests supply advanced service (New!)

The lateral flow device (LFD) tests supply service for patients potentially eligible for COVID-19 treatments will launch on 6 November 2023. Eligible patients can obtain a free box of five LFD tests from community pharmacy.

A positive LFD result will be used by the prescriber to inform clinical assessment to determine whether the patient will benefit from COVID-19 treatments. <u>The full list of eligibility criteria can be</u> found in the NICE recommendations for COVID-19 community treatments. Further details, including pharmacy registration and the service specification, can be found on the NHS England website. Kent LPC have devised a flow chart (here) to support you in your practice.

MHRA Drug Safety Update:

Valproate: dispense full packs of valproate-containing medicines

Unless there are exceptional circumstances, valproate-containing medicines must always be dispensed in the manufacturer's original full pack.

VAT and PGD supplies

As you are aware, at the 2023 Spring Budget, the Government announced that it would extend the zero rate on medicines prescribed on prescriptions to medicines supplied under PGDs. HMRC subsequently announced that the change would occur from 9th October 2023 to 31st March 2027.

I want to flag to you all that this change **only applies** to PGD supplies where the patient is given the medicine to use.

It **does not apply** where the medicine is administered to the patient, for example vaccination services, including the flu vaccination service.

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
