Serious Shortage Protocols for Clarithromycin – Reactivation

Because of ongoing supply issues, we are reactivating the Serious

Shortage Protocols for Clarithromycin 125mg/5ml oral suspension (SSP053) and Clarithromycin 250mg/5ml (SSP054).

SSP053 allows pharmacists to instead supply 2.5ml x Clarithromycin 250mg/5ml oral suspension SSP054 allows pharmacists to instead supply 1 x Clarithromycin 250mg tablet

The reactivated SSPs came into effect from 22 May 2024, and are scheduled to end on Friday 21 June.

The SSPs are available to view on the NHS Business Service Authority (BSA)'s <u>dedicated SSP web page</u>.
