

#### Flu vac: PGD and national protocol published

NHS England (NHSE) have approved the patient group direction (PGD) for use by community pharmacy owners during the forthcoming flu vaccination season. This follows publication of the national protocol earlier in the week by the UK Health Security Agency.

The publication of both documents, follows updates to the <u>flu service</u> <u>specification</u> following the amendment to the National Flu Immunisation Programme 2024/25 letter, in response to <u>the news</u> that the Sanofi recombinant quadrivalent influenza vaccine (QIVr) will not be available for the 2024/25 flu vaccination programme.

### <u>Community Pharmacy Assurance Framework (CPAF) screening</u> <u>questionnaire (</u>Deadline!)

Pharmacy contractors should soon receive confirmation from NHSBSA that the CPAF screening questionnaire will go live on **1 July 2024** and will be available for completion until midnight on **31 July**.

Users of the <u>NHSBSA's Manage Your Service (MYS)</u> portal will be able to complete this year's CPAF by logging in. The very small number of contractors who do not have a sign in for MYS will be able to complete the questionnaire online and will receive email details on how to do this.

Completion of the screening questionnaire is compulsory, and the results of the questionnaire will form the basis of which contractors will be asked to complete the full CPAF survey and may be visited later.


<u>Location</u>: Crowne Plaza London - Gatwick Airport, 90 Langley Dr, Crawley RH11 7SX
