Kent & Medway Funded DPP Pilot to Support Community Pharmacists open for EOIs until 9th February 2025

We are pleased to share that we will be offering £1000-£1500 funding (per trainee prescriber) to the employing organisation of a limited number of active prescribers willing to provide Designated Prescribing Practitioner services within Kent & Medway. The aim is to provide **community pharmacists** with the necessary training and supervision to qualify as independent prescribers. This will help to build prescribing and supervision infrastructure across Kent & Medway in primary care (with a focus on community pharmacy).

Please note that the Expressions of Interest will be open until **midnight Sunday 9**th **February**

Kent and Medway Pharmacy Contraception Workshop

We want to say a massive thank you to all pharmacists and pharmacy technicians that attended and contributed to the success of the event.

The Community Pharmacy England highlighted the 31st March 2025 deadline for pharmacy owners delivering Pharmacy First to also deliver: Pharmacy Contraception Service and Hypertension Case-Finding Service. This ensures eligibility for the monthly £1,000 fixed payment, provided relevant consultation thresholds are met.

We are excited to continue supporting the development of enhanced pharmacy services across Kent and Medway to better serve the health needs of our communities.



Important Update: Smoking Cessation locally commissioned Service – Varenicline PGD

We are currently negotiating the inclusion of a Patient Group Direction (PGD) for Varenicline as part of the locally commissioned smoking cessation service in community pharmacy.

While these negotiations are ongoing, we strongly recommend that pharmacy contractors refrain from signing any contracts related to the service until the discussions are finalized.

We will provide a further update through all our communication channels as soon as the negotiations are complete and a final agreement is reached.
