NHS Flu Vaccination Booking System	Pharmacy Income	11 th August 2025	Community pharmacies not already registered with the National Booking System (NBS) can now apply to join the NBS flu vaccination service. To apply, click here to complete the NBS Onboarding Form with your pharmacy ODS code and contact details of two users. For applicants between July 24th and August 11th, you will receive login details before August 18th. All other applicants will receive the login details within 10 working days. The booking system will be open for bookings from members of the public from September 1st to January 31st, 2026, for COVID vaccination, and from September 1st to March 31st, 2026, for Flu Vaccination.
