Serious Shortage Protocols for Cefalexin - (extension)

Because of ongoing supply issues, we are extending the Serious Shortage Protocols SSP077 (Cefalexin 125mg/5ml oral suspension sugar free) and SSP078 (Cefalexin 250mg/5ml oral suspension sugar free) which are due to end on the 1st and 8th of August respectively. The new end date for these SSPs is Friday 26 September 2025.

The SSPs are available to view on the NHS Business Service Authority (BSA)'s <u>dedicated SSP web page</u>.

Registration now open for the flu vaccination service for two and threeyear-olds

Please be advised that contractors can register to provide the **community pharmacy flu vaccination service for two and three-year-olds** on the <u>Manage Your Service (MYS) portal</u> from today (1 August 2025).

Contractors must read the <u>service specification</u> for the full requirements of service delivery, and consider if they are able to meet these.

Updating your NHS Profile Manager

Pharmacy owners are reminded of the benefits of regularly updating their NHS Profile Manager each quarter, ensuring their NHS website and Directory of Services (DoS) profile information remains current.

Accurate DoS information is essential for other organisations making referrals to pharmacies and is a Terms of Service requirement. Up-to-date opening hours are crucial to prevent NHS 111 health advisors and GP practice teams from directing patients to a closed pharmacy, for example, for the Pharmacy First service.

The Pharmacy Quality Scheme (PQS) forms part of the Community Pharmacy Contractual Framework (CPCF). PQS is designed to reward community pharmacies for delivering quality criteria that are designed to support clinical effectiveness, patient safety and patient experience.

Please note, NHS England will not be publishing PQS guidance for pharmacy owners for the 2025/26 Scheme.
