Kent Sexual Health Social Media Toolkit

Kent County Council (KCC) has updated its <u>sexual health pages</u> and service <u>directory</u> to improve access to information and support.

As part of this work, a new sexual health campaign will run from November through to December, aligned with this year's strategic objectives and informed by insights from the recent needs assessment and agency engagement. It has two target audiences, one 16-24 years and another, 25-50 years which are represented by different creatives.
